Live Stream Frequently Asked Questions

► How do I get to the Live Stream?

To access the live stream event, connect your device to an Internet browser and enter this link:

Please try to connect 10 minutes early to ensure a good connection for the kick-off events.

► Do I need special equipment?

No special equipment needed. Any device that can hook up to an adequate Internet connection and a browser should work. This includes mobile phone, tablets, laptops... If you are planning to live stream with equipment such as a projection screen, you may wish to ensure setup and testing ahead of the event.

► Is there a cost to access the Live Streaming?

The Live Streaming event is free. You will need to have your own access to the Internet via your local provider or such.

► Can a few students watch the Live Streaming rather than a full classroom?

Yes, if individuals have access to the Internet, they can access this event via an appropriate device and Internet connection.
